Notes (1)

Natalia Nikolaevna Dudar is a judge at the Basmanny District Court in Moscow. In her position, she has issued a number of rulings against peaceful protesters and political opponents, including employees of Alexey Navalny's Anti-Corruption Foundation (FBK), Ilia Yashin and Vladimir Kara-Murza. She issued orders to conduct searches of employees of the FBK and wiretap their phones. She extended the arrest in pre-trial detention centre of Lilia Chanyшева, former Head of Navalny's headquarters in Ufa, who was accused of creating an extremist community. Natalia Nikolaevna Duda is therefore responsible for serious human rights violations in Russia, in particular arbitrary arrests or detentions, and the violation of freedom of opinion and expression which is of serious concern as regards the objectives of the common foreign and security policy set out in Article 21 TEU.
