Member of the Central Military Commission of the Workers' Party of Korea, which is a key body for national defence matters in the DPRK. Member and Secretary of the Presidium of the Politburo of the ruling Party's Central Committee. In these roles, Pak Jong-Chon has proven to be responsible for supporting or promoting the DPRK's nuclear-related, ballistic missile-related or other weapons of mass destruction-related programmes.

Colonel General (Lieutenant General) in the Korean People's Army Chief of the General Staff since April 2019, member of the Politburo since April 2020. Former member of the Central Military Commission of the Workers' Party of Korea, which is a key body for national defence matters in the DPRK. As such, responsible for supporting or promoting the DPRK's nuclear-related, ballistic missile-related or other weapons of mass destruction-related programmes.
